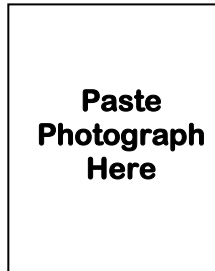

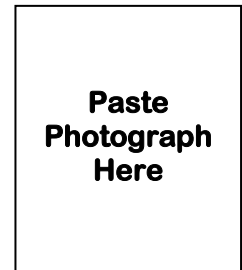

DIRECTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES FOR THE EXAMINATION

- The doors of the examination hall shall be opened atleast ten minutes before the examination is due to commence. Before entering the examination hall, the candidate must leave outside any books, notes or paper he may have with him.
- The candidate must occupy the seal allotted to him.
- The candidate must show his admit card on demand and he may be asked to give his specimen signature for identification.
- No candidate shall be permitted to enter the examination hall after the expiry of or to leave the examination hall before the expiry of half an hour after the distribution of the question paper.
- The candidate should write his Roll Number in the space provided on the Answer Book. He shall not disclose his identity or make any distinctive mark in the answer book for that purpose.

- Examination fee can be paid by cash/cheque at all branches of Axis Bank** or by Crossed Banker's cheque or Demand Draft payable at New Delhi in favour of 'The Aeronautical Society of India'. Cheques, Cash, Postal Orders or Mail Transfer Receipts shall not be accepted.
- Ensure that your membership subscription of Rs.500/- for the current year has been paid. **Students members who have registered after payment of Rs.5000/- as registration fee are exempted from payment of annual subscription.**
- Last date of receipt of Examination application form is 10th of April/ October without late fee and 25th of April/October with late fee (Rs.500/-) for the June/December session respectively.
- The application form should be accompanied by two self addressed envelopes for dispatch of Admit Card/Date Sheet and Result Sheet/Application Form for the next Session.
- Examination is conducted at present at 13 centres viz. Bangalore, Chennai, Delhi, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Indore, Kanpur, Kochi, Kharagpur, Mumbai, Nagpur, Pune & Thiruvananthapuram.
- Any application form which is incomplete or does not fulfil the prescribed conditions or has been received after the last date specified for receipt of application forms for the session, shall be rejected.
- Please quote your Registration Number, Examination Centre and Roll No. for any queries.**
- Examination fee is not refundable. If the examination could not be conducted for some reason, the fee paid shall be adjusted for the examination in the following session.**
- Validity of registration is 8 years. Those who are unable to complete within time frame of 8 years, their registration will stand cancelled. Those student members who want to pursue will have to register afresh and appear in all the papers.**
